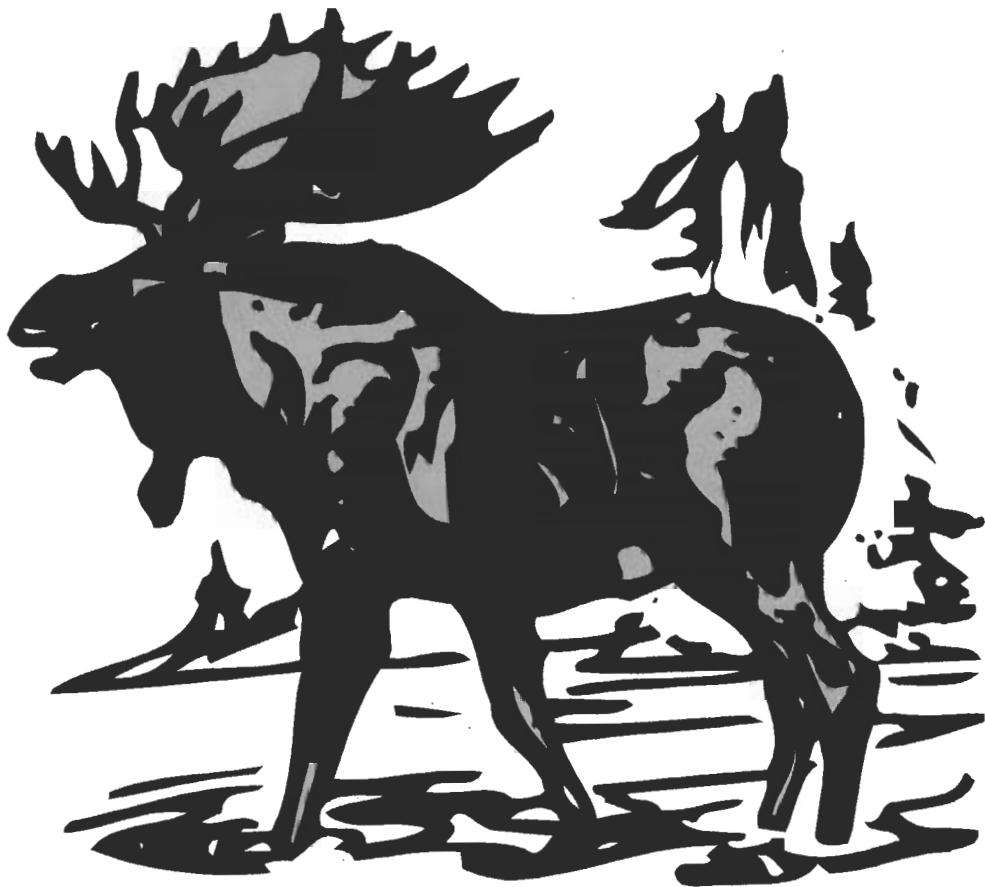

THANK YOU FOR VISITING WARREN AND THE WINTER INN. WE HOPE YOU ENJOY YOUR VISIT. SOMETIMES WE DON'T HAVE TIME TO ANSWER ALL YOUR QUESTIONS. WE ARE SORRY. SO HERE ARE A FEW ANSWERS JUST IN CASE.

- ☞ WARREN WAS ESTABLISHED IN 1862 WHEN GOLD WAS DISCOVERED.
- ☞ WARREN IS THE 5TH OLDEST TOWN IN IDAHO.
- ☞ WARREN'S POPULATION IN IT'S BOOM WAS AROUND 5,000.
- ☞ WARREN'S CURRENT POPULATION IS 9-16 YEAR AROUND AND 45-50 IN THE SUMMER.
- ☞ WARREN IS ALSO A RECREATION TOWN WITH WEEKEND CABINS AND FOLKS THAT JUST WANT TO GET AWAY.
- ☞ WARREN'S CHINESE POPULATION WAS AROUND 1300 IN THE 1870'S. THEY PLACER MINED WARREN AND FARMED DOWN TOWARDS HAY STATION. OUR ARTIFACTS IN THE CASE WERE FOUND WITHIN THE TOWN SITE OF WARREN.
- ☞ WARREN WAGON ROAD IS OPEN ONLY IN THE SUMMER AND IS A GROOMED SNOWMOBILE TRAIL IN THE WINTER. WE RECEIVE OUR MAIL AND FREIGHT BY SKI PLANE.
- ☞ THE DREDGES CAME TO WARREN IN THE 1930'S AND STAYED UNTIL 1941 WHEN NON-ESSENTIAL MINING WAS STOPPED BY THE WAR.
- ☞ EXCEPT FOR A FEW PRIVATE CABINS, THE ORIGINAL BUILDINGS OF WARREN WERE BURNED IN A FIRE IN 1900. THE BUILDINGS YOU SEE IN WARREN TODAY WERE BUILT FROM 1901 TO APPROXIMATELY 1930.
- ☞ WARREN DOES NOT HAVE ELECTRICITY; HOWEVER, TELEPHONE LINES WERE INSTALLED NOVEMBER 1995.
